Requirements for selection in program:

- Sophomore or Junior
- Have and maintain a 3.0 GPA
- 1 reference from a faculty or administrator (we will reach out once you have confirmed the reference)
- Complete parent permission and disclosure form
- 1-page essay about what the applicant hopes to gain from this program
- WEEKLY Time commitment February April 2023: (1) Lunch AND (1) After-school Meeting

Steps to Apply for Girls Got GRIT:

1. APPLICATION FORM: Complete/sign this application (2 pages), email to GirlsGotGrit@Sacredhearts.org **2. FACULTY REFERENCE:** Put the name of one faculty member on application form as a personal reference.

3. PARENT DISCLOSURES: Complete parent/guardian permission form (Page 2)

4. ESSAY: Write a TYPED one-page essay about why you are a good fit for the GGG program and what you hope to accomplish being a part of this program.

5. INTERVIEW: After application, parent disclosure, and essay are turned in BY SEPTEMBER 23, an Interview will be scheduled. NEW DEADLINE FRIDAY SEPT 30, 2022
